

Local Rules

1. DROP ZONE - 11th Gainsborough behind ladies tee: If there is a chance that the ball may be lost outside the Lateral Water Hazard, then the player must play a provisional ball under Rule 27-2. If the player does not do so, he/she should go forward to search for said ball and if it then transpires that there is reasonable evidence that the ball is in the Lateral Water Hazard, the player may drop under Rule 26-1, or as an additional option, drop with the Drop Zone for a one stroke penalty. Once a new ball is dropped it becomes the ball in play irrespective of whether or not the original ball is subsequently found.

2. AERATION HOLES - Through the green, a ball which comes to rest in or on an aeration hole, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. On the putting green, the player shall place the ball at the nearest spot not nearer the hole which avoids the situation.

3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR) - as well as items marked GUR in the following areas the player must take relief, without penalty, under Rule 25.1 Temporary greens, main greens when not in play, are wrong greens. Molehills, compacted tractor ruts old or new. Bunkers with green keeper workings being carried out.

4. PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:

Match Play - Loss of Hole
Stroke Play - Two Strokes

5. PROVISIONAL BALL 10TH HOLE

If a player considers that his approach shot to the green on the 10th hole may be in the water hazard, he may play a provisional ball under rule 26/1. If the player subsequently discovers that his ball is in the hazard, then he may choose to play the original ball as it lies or he can continue play with the provisional ball, thus maintaining pace of play.
